

Sponsorship

- Intakes are in Year 7 and Year 8 only
- The bursary is funded by the following three bodies:
 - A private sponsor who commits to sponsor a boy throughout his time at the College
 - o The AIEF
 - ABSTUDY

Application

- Applications to be received by 1 June in the year prior to enrolment
- All applications need to include the following:

 - o A recent photo of the applicant
 - Most recent NAPLAN results
 - Most recent school report
 - A hand-written 250-word essay on why the application thinks he should be awarded a scholarship.

Process

Stage 1: Mail the full application, as outlined above to:
