Fee Payment Information

Fees are paid fortnightly, two weeks in advance. A full session fee is charged regardless of the number of hours your son/s attends. Parents and carers are required to pay for the full term of operation while your son/s is enrolled at the service. School holiday periods will not be charged as Before or After School Care times.

Account statements are issued by email fortnightly. It is the parent's or carer's responsibility to register with the Department of Human Services (www.mygov.com.au) for childcare entitlements. You must





forward the following information for Child Care Subsidy (CCS) to be processed by the centre. Please include your Customer Reference Number (CRN), son/s' date of birth, parent or carer CRN, and parent or carer date of birth.

Fees are required to be paid using debitsuccess, this is the only method of payment accepted. Direct debit payments can be set up from your credit card or bank account. Any queries in relation to billing can be addressed by calling Administration on (02) 9526 7000.

Daily Information

Meals: Well balanced, nutritious meal options are offered by the centre, including breakfast and afternoon tea. Please speak with the nominated supervisor for more details on our meal plans. Feedback regarding our meal plans is always welcomed and encouraged.

Daily Program: During your son/s' time with The Scots College BASC, they will have the opportunity to participate in a number of fun, hands-on experiences including: craft activities, construction, board games, puzzles, imaginative play, group games, outdoor sports and cooking experiences.

Curriculum Facts

Our program follows the 'My Time, Our Place' Framework. This curriculum focuses on collaboration between the children and educators to provide play and leisure opportunities that are meaningful to children and support their wellbeing, learning and development. Our environment pays close attention to the needs and interests of individual children. An emphasis is put on children having choice and control over their learning as they collaborate with friends and educators to extend their life skills and develop dispositions towards community participation.

Educators

The nominated supervisor is responsible for the overall implementation of the program at The Scots College BASC. The nominated supervisor is also the first point of contact for parents and carers to communicate with regarding the program and matters affecting their son/s.

Educators are employed using a minimum ratio of 1:15 and all educators hold a Working with Children Check. At least one educator on the premises will hold a current First Aid Certificate and child protection qualification. All educators are recognised responsible people. Additional staff are rostered to oversee child supervision between after SEA and BASC.

Our educators are experienced in the provision of care and recreational activities for children. They role-model positive interactions in an energetic, empathetic, caring, fun and reliable way. They extend children's knowledge through scaffolding learning and creating a program which supports children's interests.
